

## Student Instructions

Your team of three will have one hour of online time to answer ten questions.

The team that answers the most questions correctly over the three rounds of the competition will win.

TEAM WORK is the key!



### INSTRUCTIONS WHEN ENTERING ANSWERS:

- Do not use units of measurement in your answer unless requested (ie. \$, cm, kg, etc.)
- Use correct spelling and grammatical English.
- Use capital letters for proper nouns (names of people and things) and sentence beginnings.
- Place only ONE space between separate words and numbers.
- Ensure you click on “*Submit all and finish*” when you have finished the quiz by answering all ten questions

### SUGGESTED APPROACH:

- ✓ Read all questions carefully before entering any answers.
- ✓ Listen carefully to everyone’s ideas. Consider all options.
- ✓ Discuss the best ways of finding the correct answers. Use as many resources as possible. (However, make sure you don’t accidentally log off the AFL Student Quiz site when you use the internet.)
- ✓ Share the questions amongst the three team members.
- ✓ Set deadlines and team meeting times. Make group decisions.
- ✓ Nominate a team member to enter the answers into the site. Be careful! Correct spelling definitely counts. This includes the correct use of capital letters. Watch out that you don’t accidentally put in two spaces between words and numbers or spaces in front of words.
- ✓ After your team has finished and you have your scores, debrief your problem solving strategies.
- ✓ Can you decide why your team got particular answers wrong?
- ✓ Do you know which processes produced the correct answers?
- ✓ What are your team’s strengths and weaknesses?
- ✓ What can you do to work more quickly and accurately as a team in the next round?
- ✓ But most importantly ... **have fun and enjoy yourself!**
